Description of location:	<p>Beautifully located in the countryside in the middle of the Nationalpark Mols Bjerger, with the beach a few minutes walking distance and the forest in our backyard.</p> <p>The school is situated only 35 km north of Aarhus - the second largest city in Denmark and European Capital of Culture 2017. Aarhus offers many cultural activities (theater, concerts, films, museums), a diversity of restaurants, shopping and a vibrant waterfront in the summer. Aarhus is accessible by public transportation within an hour.</p> <p>If you prefer nature, then the surrounding environment is the ideal place to enjoy your stay and explore.</p> <p>Here the conditions for studying language and culture, and having an adventure holiday are just perfect.</p> 
Leisure	<p>The recreational landscape, the historical monuments, the distinctive nature, the sea and the forest, including the school's own facilities give you exceptional possibilities for spending your spare time with a lot of fun: all kinds of sports are available, such as volleyball, basketball, football, badminton, table tennis, pool etc. and outdoor-activities like kayaking, biking, hiking, fishing, stand-up-paddling, swimming, and sleeping in an outdoor shelter.</p>

**The Kalø Folk High School was founded in 1952. A Folk High School is a boarding school for adults, who want to concentrate on specific topics.**


**The main purpose is: to give the students a general, democratic education with teaching on two different topics:**

<p><b>Meals:</b></p>	<p>Meals will be served from the Nordic Kitchen with some of the best Nordic and international recipes. There will be three meals served per day during the week and two meals at the weekend.</p> 
<p><b>Reception of students:</b></p>	<p>We would like to welcome you on Sunday, July 7th between 3:00 and 5:30 p.m. Refreshments and a snack will be served upon your arrival. Dinner will be served at 5:30 p.m. During dinner you will be informed of the schedule for Monday morning when classes start. There is public transportation to the school. <p><b>Extra-mural activities:</b></p>	<p>In addition to the language classes, there are several activities that you can join in your spare time, along with the Danish students. Some examples are salsa, yoga, sports, sing-a-song and a lot more.</p> <p>Every evening there will be served tea/coffee and a light snack.</p> <p>Every morning after breakfast, we start the day together with a short assembly in the Auditorium. This can include a news story, singing a song, or short presentation on a topic.</p>
